MePA supports LD 1735: An Act to Safeguard Gender-affirming Health Care, in a general sense. As an association for psychologists, we agree with the importance of protecting gender affirming healthcare. The American Psychological Association (APA), as well as other healthcare organizations, (e.g., American Counseling Association, World Professional Association for Transgender Health) have established empirically supported practice guidelines that encourage clinicians to use gender-affirming practices when addressing gender identity issues (ACA, 2010; APA, 2015; Coleman et al., 2012).
