What a novel idea to create a fund at the state level to incentivize the planning and building of transitional housing, both for families and for singles, around the state service hubs. Transitional housing will allow the current homeless in shelters to move into a space of their own to get their feet under them, to obtain the services they need, and to use the two years of transitional housing to prepare themselves for independent living.
