Federal and state laws ensuring that schools are gun-free zones have helped make K-12 schools even safer, significantly reducing gun violence in these places. School-associated student homicide rates decreased after the federal laws restricting guns within 1,000 feet of schools were adopted in the early 1990s.

Aren't we already asking enough of school aged students, making kindergarteners perform active shooter drills because it is necessary in today's world? Allowing someone to be shooting 500 feet away, when misfires and stray bullets are possible is just reckless.
