Senator Pierce, Representative Gere, and honorable members of the Committee on Housing: my name is Raina Overskride, I live in Lewiston Maine and I am here today to testify in favor of LD-1710.

The reason I support LD-1710 is for the simple fact that housing is a human right and everyone deserves a safe and affordable home.

The growing housing and homeless crisis within Maine is proof that bills like LD-1710 are needed.

Far too many people are struggling just to cover rent while working two and sometimes three jobs just to afford rent and that is not even taking into account the increased cost of living many of us are struggling with.
