I learned the hard way, that companies don't care about their workers, unless the government incentivizes them too- and it's affected my work history, my mental health, my savings account, my relationships - compared to other people my age. If there was a system like Paid leave that could have helped me earlier on, I probably would have started my career on more equal footing, earned more money, had better mental health, and my mom would have been able to be there for her father too at the very beginning. This is why I support LD1964. This bill was needed a long time ago- and it's about time we enact it.
