Dear Senator Tipping, Representative Roeder, and honorable members of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor and Housing,

My name is Christina Correnti and I live in Portland. I am writing today in support of paid family and medical leave for Maine.

When my daughter was born in 2017, I had no paid leave available. I had to choose between taking unpaid leave, or returning to work while still recovering from labor and delivery. Ultimately I took 11 weeks of unpaid leave from my job, which erased much of our family's hard-earned savings. Still, I was luckier than many other parents who do not have the financial option of taking any unpaid leave.

Paid leave would offer parents much-needed time to bond with their newborns, and offer birthing parents a chance to recover physically before returning to work. It would also make it easier for companies to retain employees who become new parents.
