My name is Rob Simopoulos, and I am the Co-Founder of Defendify with its head office located in Portland, Maine. We are a venture-stage cybersecurity company whose all-in-one cybersecurity platform helps small to medium-sized businesses quickly improve their security posture. Our unique solution enables businesses without an internal security team to maintain data security and helps them navigate the complex cybersecurity landscape to defend their organization against evolving threats.

I am expressing my support for the renewal of the Maine New Markets Capital Investment Program (LD 1974), an economic development program aimed at promoting investment, creating jobs, stimulating economic growth, and revitalizing underserved communities.
