Mothers and children's lives and health will be at risk if this bill becomes law. Only 22% of the public polled in 2023 favored abortions in the third trimester. That is what LD 1619 last year passed. This bill would add it to our Constitution making it impossible to keep the commonsense protections we currently have in Statute like parental consent, informed consent, etc.
