**LD 2161, An Act to Make Technical Corrections to the Maine Juvenile Code, the Maine Criminal Code and the Intelligence and Investigative Record Information Act**

Senator Beebe-Center, Representative Salisbury and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety, I am Randall Liberty, Commissioner of the Maine Department of Corrections (DOC) providing testimony in support of LD 2161, An Act to Make Technical Corrections to the Maine Juvenile Code, the Maine Criminal Code and the Intelligence and Investigative Record Information Act.

This is a simple bill making technical corrections to the Maine Juvenile Code, the Maine Criminal Code and the Intelligence and Investigative Record Information Act. The only provisions in the bill that relate to the Department of Corrections are those that amend the provisions in the Maine Juvenile Code regarding the sealing of juvenile records by adding a cross-reference and correcting a reference to juvenile history record information. This a mere technical correction that was missed the last time these provisions were updated. While the DOC is in support of this bill, this correction will ultimately have no substantive impact on the department.
