LD 2158, An Act to Improve the Housing Voucher System

Senator Pierce, Representative Gere and distinguished members of the Committee on Housing, my name is Amanda Campbell, and I am submitting testimony in support of LD 2158 on behalf of the Maine Municipal Association (MMA), and the 70-member Legislative Policy Committee (LPC), who were elected by their colleagues and peers to determine MMA's position on bills of municipal interest.
