The requirement to emboss each individual edible cannabis product with the universal symbol for cannabis is problematic. Some edible products are more conducive to this requirement than others. A gummy, for example may have a clear stamp prior to coating it with a product which allows them to be in a bottle without sticking together.

Asking the inspectors to use their own judgement then adds a layer of subjectivity which may allow the exact same product to pass under one inspector and fail under another one. The container already has the symbol on it. Having the symbol on the product as well is redundant and unnecessary.
