This puts me at a financial deficit. I count on the money from all of the spots. This is making it so I do not want to accept subsidy children anymore. I know that many daycares feel this way and many said they don't accept it anymore now because of this. I know parents are already having a hard time to find daycare, and if more of us refuse to accept the program, those parents will suffer the consequences.

With the large increase in expenses, my daycare doesn't have a lot of extra money left after everything is paid. If I have something happen, like a broken furnace, etc, I will not have the money to replace it. Having the funds available to help in an emergency situation would definitely make the difference of staying open or closing.
