## L.D., 2112 An Act to Replace the Money Transmitters Act.

Under current Maine law, payroll processors are not money transmitters and are defined separately in statute. Payroll processing services are defined at 10 MRS 1495. Money transmitters are defined at 32 MRS 6102. The Independent Payroll Provider Association (IPPA) and The Payroll Group (TPG) appreciates the Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection's exemption of payroll processors in LD 2112 and supports its passage with this exemption in place.
