Sen. Carney, Rep. Moonen and members of the Judiciary Committee, my name is Jim Briggs and I live in North Yarmouth.

I am writing to testify in support of LD 2007.

Please support LD 2007, An Act To Advance Self-determination for Wabanaki Nations.

This bill would substantially change the Maine Indian Claims Settlement Implementing Act. That Law currently prevent the Wabanaki Nations in Maine from exercising their inherent right to self govern. All other Federally recognized tribes in the United States have that right under Federal Indian Law.

With a multi-generational property in Topsfield our family has traveled through the Passamaquoddy Indian Reservation on the way to Princeton for decades. Sadly, the Reservation has been unable to make much progress due to restrictions imposed by the 1980 Maine Indian Claims Settlement Act (MICSA). I believe passage of LD 2007 will remove obstacles the Wabanaki Nations in Maine have faced since 1980.

I thank the Committee for taking this testimony. LD 2007 returns the rights of self government that became wrongfully restricted, by the 1980 MICSA. LD 2007 deserves passage!
