The current Settlement Act prevents Maine tribes from self-governing and from fully exercising their rights.

Thank you for considering my thoughts. As a citizen of Maine, and of this country, knowing all that has been taken from tribes in Maine, and across this country, and knowing all that stills separates them from an equitable existence, here and beyond, I implore you to act in support of LD 2027.
