We must hold to our commitment to them, though indeed many commitments in the past have shamefully been broken.

Thank you for your time and attention to right this long standing issue. We owe these people the sovereignty of self-determination that has been long overdue. Respectfully, to do any less is a blight on the integrity of the State that we all call our home.
