Sen. Carney, Rep. Moonen and members of the Judiciary Committee, my name is Becky McKinnell and I live in Cumberland. I am a business owner of iBec Creative, a digital agency headquartered in Portland. I am here to testify in support of LD 2007.

I recently attended the kick off for Businesses for Wabanaki Sovereignty at Patagonia in Freeport. I was made aware of this event through Maine B Corps, as iBec Creative is a Certified B Corp and attended to learn more about LD2007. I was surprised to learn about the restrictions imposed by the 1980 Maine Indian Claims Settlement Act (MICSA) and how the Wabanaki Nations have been kept from achieving the significant economic growth experienced by the other 570 federal tribes over the past 40 years who've had full access to federal policies of self-determination. I am in support of LD2007 to remove those obstacles so the Wabanaki Nations take advantage of federal self-determination policies, programs and funding that elsewhere in Indian Country led to the creation of thousands of jobs and hundreds of millions of dollars in goods and services produced by Native businesses
