Sen. Carney, Rep. Moonen and members of the Judiciary Committee,

My name is Liz Eisele McLellan and I live on the unceded lands of the Wabanaki people, in what is now called Westbrook. I am writing to testify in support of LD 2007.

The more that I learn about how this country called America was born, the more that I look around at the current systems, policies, and institutions that surround us. I can see the stamp of our history embedded deep within—the pain, the trauma, and the power. As we are faced with some of the greatest challenges of our lifetime, we are also presented with powerful opportunities to repair and reconcile some of the harms of the past. LD 2007 is one such opportunity.

The history of white settler colonialism on Turtle Island, and here in the Dawnland, has been devastating to indigenous populations. That devastation has been continued in many different ways over the centuries, all the way to the time where we find ourselves now.

And I am curious to know, how will you act differently than those that came before you? How will you divest yourselves of the harmful practices and policies that have been commonplace in the effort to sustain white supremacy at all levels of our government, including this one?

Governance is about how decisions are made and who makes the decisions. White folks have been making the decisions for Maine tribes for too long. You have heard their demands for sovereignty before. It is time to listen. LD 2007 is a bill that will return sovereign rights to Maine's indigenous tribes that should never have been stripped away by MICSA.

I hope you are able to see the value in passing a bill that delivers on humanity and equity; that will allow the Wabanaki to partake in federal programs meant to benefit U.S. tribal populations. Returning sovereignty to Maine's indigenous tribes is akin to seeing them for who they are. Do not continue to relegate them to a place of discrimination and "less than". It is time to acknowledge their right to self-determination.

Thank you for your time and please vote to pass LD 2007. It is time.
