

My name is William Harwood, here today as Public Advocate, to present testimony in support of the Governor's Recommended General Fund Supplemental Budget 2024-2025. Specifically to support its budget initiative: "Continues and makes permanent one Senior Counsel position previously continued by Financial Order 002871 F4," as outlined on page A-50 of the Budget Document.

Pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. Ch. 17 §1702, this Senior Counsel position is essential to the overall success of the OPA and will function in planning, coordinating, and representing the interests of the Maine users of utility services, including electricity, natural gas, water and telecommunications proceedings before the Maine Public Utilities Commission, Maine Supreme Judicial Court, the Maine Legislature, and applicable federal regulatory bodies. The Senior Counsel position is funded through an assessment on utilities pursuant to 35-A M.RS., Subsection 116.
