This statute, as proposed, would create victims of thousands of Mainers, especially women, who are the subject of domestic violence, stalkers, and abusers. LD 2224 would leave these women without a means to immediately protect themselves from an imminent threat. For example, under LD 2224, I could not transfer a firearm to a female friend on an evening in which no FFL's are open after her abuser makes threats, leaving this woman defenseless. Very few guns used in crimes have been bought through a private transaction. Most have actually completed background checks for their firearms. So not only does this bill not solve any real problems, it creates a black hole of defenselessness for abused and at risk women.
