I am writing AGAINST LD 227 of the 131st Legislature as amended as of March 5, 2024. I am opposed to abortion in principle. I, along with thousands of other Mainers, view abortion as the taking of a human life. While there may arguably be limited cases in which abortion may seem sensible (as in the cases of the endangered life of the mother or rape), this legislation makes allowance and provision for abortion in general and at any stage.
