I David M. Colvin of Pittston Maine oppose LD 2283 - An Act to Enact the Crisis Intervention Order Act to Protect the Safety of the Public. LD - 2283 circumvents due process and is a direct violation of both the 2nd amendment and 4th amendment.

Amendment IV- The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated and no warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the person's or things to be sized.

LD - 2283 would essentially accuse people of a crime before a crime is committed and confiscate legally owned property under the premise of suspicion alone without any articulable evidence against the accused individual.
