Currently, the sales tax imposes financial and administrative burdens on us for durable medical equipment and supply items that are not currently tax exempt, especially since MaineCare and other insurers do not always reimburse this expense. Removing this taxation will allow us to continue reinvesting in our services for the community through increased product offerings and coverage area.
