I believe this bill offers an effective approach to tackling this problem by supporting the DEP and IFW to work together. By providing necessary tools and resources to monitor, manage and strengthen inspection standards at infected lake sites, this bill will help protect the integrity of our ecosystems and improve water quality across the state.
