

Maine State Legislature Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs 2/12/2025

RE: LD 210 - An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations from the General Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2025, June 30, 2026, and June 30, 2027.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony in support of LD 210 and for Health and Human Services and their commitment they continue to provide for the DME industry here in Maine.

Bedard supports maintaining MaineCare funding, as proposed, to hold their rate alignment with Medicare for Medicare covered DME but does request annual CPI adjustments for non-Medicare DME to be included in the funds for Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2025, June 30, 2026, and June 30, 2027. Not including those CPI adjustments increases the chance that DME's may have to reduce or eliminate the items offered if they become unprofitable due to inflationary pressures.

This independence is crucial for maintaining mental and emotional health, as it promotes social interaction and engagement in daily activities. By facilitating mobility and accessibility, DME helps to reduce the feelings of isolation and dependence that many individuals with disabilities experience.

Support for Chronic Conditions

For individuals with chronic conditions such as diabetes, arthritis, and cardiovascular diseases, DME offers essential tools for ongoing disease management. For instance, blood glucose monitors, insulin pumps, and continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) machines are critical for managing diabetes and sleep apnea, respectively. Medicare and Medicaid Reimbursement

In the United States, Medicare and Medicaid play a crucial role in supporting the DME industry by providing reimbursement for approved medical equipment. This reimbursement framework ensures that patients have access to necessary devices without facing prohibitive out-of-pocket costs.

In 2023 the Maine Department of Health and Human Services adopted rules aligning MaineCare's DME rates with Medicare rates, including rental classifications and rates, ensuring compliance with P.L. 2021, ch. 398. It also adhered to P.L. 2021, ch. 639, by incorporating annual inflation adjustments based on the CPI for non-Medicare DME.

Those updates to align MaineCare's DME rates with Medicare rates, including rental classifications and rates, demonstrated the commitment to maintaining affordability and compliance with federal guidelines. Additionally, incorporating annual inflation adjustments based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for non-Medicare DME ensures that reimbursement rates remain fair and reflective of current economic conditions.

Personalized Care

Modern DME products are increasingly designed to provide personalized care tailored to the specific needs of individual patients. For example, adjustable hospital beds with customizable settings allow patients to find the most comfortable and supportive positions, thereby improving their rest and recovery. Similarly, adaptive devices such as prosthetics and orthotics are now more precisely fitted to the user, offering greater comfort and functionality. This trend towards personalization is helping to ensure that patients receive the best possible care and support from their medical equipment.



Reimbursement and Accessibility

While Medicare and Medicaid provide important support for DME reimbursement, there are still gaps in coverage that can limit patient access to necessary equipment. Advocacy for expanded reimbursement policies and increased funding for DME programs is crucial for ensuring that all patients can benefit from these essential devices. Additionally, efforts to raise awareness about the availability and importance of DME can help to improve accessibility and utilization.
