Testimonials for LD- 18 and LD-45 are as follows:

- (1) LD-18 / the reason for the Doc to increase the medical co pay is said to be so that hospice workers can be paid, when in reality not one hospice worker at the Maine State Prison has asked to be paid. A small increase in the co pay would be understandable as everything has gone up in price, but an increase of five times over to pay a group of residents who simply refuse to bee paid is at the very least discrimination and unconstitutional.

(f)We are going on four months and nothing has changed with residents having no access to legal research.
