Specifically, it allows the Department of Environmental Protection to adopt rules allowing the fortification of dwellings in areas of special flood hazard or coastal high impact zones through the use of fill, riprap or rocks and native vegetation.

MAR supports the proposal of LD 488 that would give maximum choice to property owners to protect their property in a proactive and comprehensive manner. Maine property owners are vulnerable to increasing environmental challenges because Maine has the most coastline of any state on the East Coast – 3,478 miles of tidal coastline. The bill is a reasonable approach to allow homeowners to protect their properties while balancing considerations of environmental impact.
