For a member of the public or an elected official to knowingly share personal details or photographs (even those that are publicly available) of anyone, but especially of a minor, without their express consent, and with the intent to cause harm such as stalking, physical harm, property damage, or creating reasonable fear for personal safety, is harmful and should be prohibited by law.
