I would like to share an experience in my life. While I was in high school in the late 1960's, my mother was an Executive Secretary for a Vice-President at IBM at their Headquarters in Harrison, New York. This was at the time when women were not only allowed to wear dresses to the office. But one day while my mom was out shopping, she brought a pant suit that she would wear to church and at social occasions. She then decided to wear it to the office. I think she was hugely brave to do this because she had no idea what the reaction would be at the office and it is not hard to imagine she might lose her job. The next day when she arrived at the office, she found a memo that had been sent out company-wide stating that women could wear pant suits appropriate to the business setting. She had initiated a culture change that affected everyone at IBM. It may seem like a small thing; however, my mother changed the policy for women, and men for that matter, at a major blue-chip company. How far have we come since the late 60's?

Passing LD 260 would be a critical step forward in establishing equal protection in our state. It's time for Maine to do the right thing- both symbolically and practically-for all Mainers, and join 29 states who have already established similar measures.

Please ensure all Mainers are recognized and protected in our constitution by ensuring Maine remains a state that stands for equality now and in the future.
