My services help keep me independent and living in my own home. Without these services I wouldn't be able to live on my own. In addition to my developmental disability and brain injury, I have been diagnosed with osteoporosis and if I were to fall it would be bad on my bones. Currently I have a support worker who comes into my home to help me with things like showering. I get my services coming in three times a week on Tuesday, Thursday, and Fridays. I need to have her help me with showering to prevent me from falling. I also have a nurse who comes in to monitor me once a month. These are all services that are necessary to live my life.

I am asking this committee to pass the developmental services budget so that I can continue to get the services I need. These services allow me to live as independently as possible.
