Thank you for the opportunity to submit this written testimony.

My name is Maya Srinivasan, I am a resident of South Berwick, ME. I am the parent of a child who identifies as non-binary. I am writing today in support of LD260.

The thought of my child potentially being discriminated against for their gender identity is unacceptable in the United States, and yet the federal government is targeting diversity, equity and inclusion. The speed at which the Trump administration is dismantling our civil liberties and protections on a federal level is the speed at which Maine must strengthen its laws preventing discrimination. LD260 needs to be passed now, to protect Maine citizens, and to further establish Maine as a state that values human dignity.
