Everyone, regardless of age, sex, gender, race, class, sexuality, should have equal rights and protections under state and national law. We have allowed the ERA to remain in progress for far too long. It's time to ensure equal rights and protection for all

I am glad that our state lawmakers have stepped up to introduce a state bill that would constitutionalize the ERA. I urge you to vote Ought to Pass on LD 260.
