I am a vendor at the Skowhegan Farmers Market. Funding to provide access to local food for those with lower income is a staple for our farmers market. The majority of our markets sales are with snap/EBT and Maine Harvest Bucks. Many of these shoppers wouldn't be able to afford nutritious balanced meals without the support of this funding. We have two paid staff at our farmers market that are entirely paid for by this funding and without it we would have no means to keep these people employed.
