Senator Curry, Representative Gere and distinguished members of the Housing and Economic Development Committee:

I am testifying AGAINST LD 427, as a resident, taxpayer, and as a local code enforcement officer.

Most communities in Maine do not have cohesive community services, public parking, public transit, a traffic ordinance, a police force, or budget to litigate, and the MEDOT does not enforce when many public safety issues arise on state owned/maintained town ways (parking on sidewalks, on lawns, in front of hydrants, etc...).

Our community is already experiencing the negative effects of mandated housing density increases that also restricted our local ability to compensate for added vehicles parked in unsafe ways.
