I support LD 266 "An Act to Require the Updating of Voter Registration Signatures".

As I understand it, this bill stipulates that, beginning January 1, 2026, a voter signature is valid for 5 years from the time it was last updated. It also requires the registrar from each municipality to review the central voter registration system annually and notify those voters whose signatures expire in that calendar year and provide those voters with a voter signature registration update form. The bill also requires the registrar to update the central voter registration system with the updated signatures.

This is common sense legislation. Voter data changes constantly. People move, people die, people change parties. Election/voter integrity has been suspect in past elections. Why would any government/municipality be afraid of transparency?

This bill once enacted into law, would help to restore registered voters faith in the fact that those on our voter lists, are supposed to be there.
