My name is Chris Hayes, and I am testifying today on behalf of both myself and my community in support of LD698, An Act to Sustain Emergency Homeless Shelters in Maine. I appreciate the opportunity to address this important issue.

Presque Isle, a small city in Northern Maine, is home to a significantly large homeless population. Given the severe weather conditions we face in our region, maintaining access to a homeless shelter is not just beneficial, but essential for the well-being and safety of our most vulnerable residents.

Rural areas like ours are often underserved when it comes to social services, food assistance, and mental health care. Consequently, law enforcement officers become one of the few resources available to homeless individuals. Without the support and shelter that our facilities provide, many of these individuals may resort to trespassing on private property or engaging in minor offenses simply to seek warmth or safety. Shelters offer a legal and safe alternative, relieving both individuals in need and local law enforcement from unnecessary and avoidable complications.

In addition to providing immediate shelter, homeless shelters also play a crucial role in connecting individuals with essential treatment services for mental health issues and

The closure of our Aroostook County Homeless Shelter would have a devastating impact on our community, further limiting the resources available to those who are already most in need.

I strongly urge you to vote **Ought to Pass** on LD698 and ensure the continued support of our homeless shelters.
