In the matter of LD 486, a bill to facilitate "stand your ground" action for gun owners, I stand opposed. It is the duty of law to keep citizens safe. This bill increases danger and decreases safety.

Everyday we hear about Artificial Intelligence, or AI. We have smartphones, smart tvs, smart cars and smart homes. We do not have smart guns. Guns require a human brain in order to be used safely.
