An individual's right to carry and keep a firearm in their vehicle, concealed or otherwise, should not hinge on that individual having a concealed carry permit. Criminals looking to inflict harm upon or steal property from others do not ask first if their victim has a concealed carry permit.

In this increasingly violent world, an individual's commute to their workplace may take them through areas where a firearm is an important tool for self-defense. An employer's dedication to the illusion of safety at the workplace should not take away from an individual's actual right to defend themselves commuting to and from work.
