I'm contacting you in opposition to LD 1126 - An Act Requiring Serial Numbers on Firearms and Prohibiting Undetectable Firearms.

Privately Made Firearms (PMFs), including those assembled or produced by individuals for personal use, are legal in the US, as long as they are not manufactured for sale or distribution. PMFs are firearms (including frames or receivers) that are completed, assembled, or otherwise produced by someone other than a licensed manufacturer and without a serial number placed by a licensed manufacturer. The ATF acknowledges the legality of manufacturing or owning homemade firearms for personal use, including 3D-printed ones, for personal use is allowed. Serial numbers are not required on these firearms.

This bill runs afoul of federal law and I urge the committee to vote "Ought Not To Pass" on LD 1126.
