To the members of the Judiciary Committee,

My name is Dan Masessa of Montville and I SUPPORT LD 424, An Act Concerning the Concealed Carrying of a Handgun by an Individual Who Is 18 Years of Age but Under 21 Years of Age.

There is no reason an individual between the ages of 18-20 years old in Maine who applies for and passes all the training and background checks should be restricted from obtaining a concealed carry permit.
