Evidence for Policy

States with magazine capacity limits experience mass shootings at half the rate compared to states without

such restrictions. The use of LCMs holding more than 10 rounds of ammunition significantly increases

the lethality of mass shooting incidents. By allowing perpetrators to fire multiple rounds in rapid

succession without reloading, LCMs intensify attacks, reducing opportunities for victims to escape or for

law enforcement and bystanders to intervene. Research demonstrates that state laws prohibiting LCMs are

associated with reductions in gun violence fatalities and injuries. To date, 14 states, including VT, NY, MA, RI, NJ, CT, MD, DE (partial ban at 17 round capacity limit), DC, IL, CO, HI,

CA, OR, and WA have

enacted laws prohibiting LCMs.
