LD 1126

I am writing to express my opposition to LD 1126 An Act Requiring Serial Numbers on Firearms and Prohibiting Undetectable Firearms. It has never been illegal throughout the history of the State of Maine for someone to manufacture their own firearms or to require serial numbers on personally manufactured firearms. This long history of freedom would now be criminalized for present and future generations by LD 1126. The first step necessary for gun confiscation is to require registration of all serial numbers.

LD 1126 would restrict law abiding citizens from getting access to unfinished frames or receivers while having zero impact on crime. What would stop criminals from obtaining unfinished frames or receivers in another state and importing them?
