Hello, i am writing in opposition to LD1126. I am against this because per the National Firearms Act of 1968, a serial number is only required for guns imported/sold after Oct 22, 1968. Guns before this date are not required to have them.

Many older and collectible firearms were made before this without serial numbers. The intent was to be able to track guns used in crimes, not to make ordinary citizens into criminals. To force serial numbers onto older family heirlooms may cause irreparable harm to a family's history and memories.

If a person engages in a business dealing with a firearm, it is required to have a serial number. The law clearly states that as long it is for personal use, it does not need one.

Also, as a minor point of fact: Article VI, Section 2 states that if a state law is in conflict with a federal law, the federal law takes precedence. I believe this law would be in conflict with the National Firearms Act of 1968. Thus, it would be overruled.
