Regarding Legislative Document 886:

Dear 132nd Maine Legislators,

In your position guiding decisions relevant to the health and welfare of your constituents, I submit to you the following opinion:

Regarding §1598-A. the medication abortions' definitions and provisions delineated in Sec.1 #2 A.,B,C (1,2,3,&4) requiring a health care professional to oversee and advise one seeking a medical abortion should be approved!

The loosening restrictions on the chemical abortion drugs mifepristone and misoprotosol and their broadened availability orchestrated by the FDA in the past has led to a rise in medication abortions in clinics across the U.S.. The two-drug protocol slowly starves a baby in the womb to death over one to two days and then induces labor and causes severe cramping, contractions, and bleeding to expel the baby from the womb. Medical supervision and oversight of this process should be the minimum care attended to anyone undergoing this physical, mental, emotional and spiritual trial in the upheaval of this life-ending procedure!
