Senator Lawrence, Representative Sachs, and esteemed members of the EUT committee:

I am writing this letter to show my support for Tracy's Quint's bill/legislative document #878 that was just submitted to the House of Representatives.

This letter is in response to Ashley Luszczki and Keneth Gartner's comments concerning the FCC, IEEE and Electromagnetic Radiation.

The studies that the IEEE (a telecommunications industry group) were involved with and/or wrote about were performed on rats that were dosed with high levels of radiation over hours. There was thermal burning of the tissues that ensued. Extra information about thermal burning from AI: Tree workers face hazards from cell antennae, especially with the proliferation of 5G installations, requiring awareness of safety measures and potential risks like burns or electric shock from working too close to antennas or high-power transmitters.

This high level radiation is found near cell tower installations for example and is not what we find in our homes. What we find is lower levels of radiation that pulsate 24/7, day in and day out, year after year from smart devices, wifi, cell towers, etc. The studies the IEEE are referencing are not long term. I am concerned about this constant pulsing radiation. There are studies that indicate how these levels cause harm to humans and bees. The honeybees are our most important food pollinators.

Dr. Paul Heroux is an Epidemiologist, Biostatistician and Occupation Health expert from McGill College in Montreal, Canada. His studies on rats took place for over two years with lower pulsing levels of radiation. His findings were that the corneas, testicles and hearts were affected adversely - cancer was found in the male rat's hearts. Other countries are taking steps to protect their citizens. Let's get Maine on board with protecting its people.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has not updated its 1996 regulations and there was a lawsuit against the FCC. Children's Health Defense won its historic case against the FCC as they challenged the 1996 health and safety guidelines for all wireless tech including 5G; the FCC has completely ignored this court order.

We cannot rely on the FCC to protect Americans.

It is up to us, we the people, to find the path to health and wellness for ALL. Please pass this bill, as our childrens' (and other generations) lives depend on it.
