Re: LD 453, An Act to Require the State to Pay 90 Percent of All General Assistance Expenses of Municipalities and Indian Tribes

Senator Ingwersen, Representative Meyer, and members of the Health and Human Services Committee, my name is Cullen Ryan, and I am the Executive Director of Community Housing of Maine or CHOM. CHOM creates housing and inclusive communities for vulnerable populations in Maine.

I am testifying in strong support of LD 453, An Act to Require the State to Pay 90 Percent of All General Assistance Expenses of Municipalities and Indian Tribes. *This bill increases from 70% to 90% the amount of state reimbursement for the costs of general assistance incurred by each municipality and Indian tribe.*

Increasing the reimbursement rate to 90% is the most important move this Legislature can make to ensure that people are served within their home communities.

The financial burden caused by the current reimbursement rate is too much of a barrier for most municipalities to overcome, causing people to leave their communities for larger service center areas.

I am hopeful the 132nd Legislature will make this important fix.

Please support LD 453 and any other bill that would improve, enhance, and expand General Assistance so we can ensure Maine's most vulnerable populations have access to vital safety net resources in their home communities. We will all be better for it.
