Testimony of Representative Holly Eaton introducing LD 1176: An Act to Provide for the Sustainable Management of Marine Resources and Create a Noncommercial Northern Shrimp License Before the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources

Senator Tepler, Representative Hepler, and colleagues on the Marine Resources Committee,

Good afternoon. For the record, I'm Representative Holly Eaton, I live in Deer Isle and I proudly represent the coastal and island towns of House District 15. I'm here today as the sponsor of LD 1176, a Department bill brought forward by the Department of Marine Resources.

This bill offers a thoughtful update to the statute governing emerging fisheries—recognizing that as ocean conditions shift, Maine needs flexible, science-based tools to respond to new opportunities like black sea bass, while ensuring sustainability and accountability from the start. It also addresses a licensing gap for northern shrimp, setting the stage for responsible access should the fishery return in the future.

These are smart, forward-thinking changes that will help position Maine to manage new or returning fisheries responsibly. I'm glad to support DMR's work on this, and I encourage the committee to give the proposal its full consideration.
