Not everyone is as kind and welcoming as she was, the entire community of workers in the brewer office never once judged me and they helped me succeed and treated my daughter and I with love and kindness.

During my time working with Haley housing was a huge need for me, I applied everywhere throughout the state and finally I got a call for a 2bedroom apartment in Portland. It was mine if I wanted it, I quickly said yes! Though I was sad to be leaving the comfort of Haley as my career advisor she made it easy for me. Haley transferred me down to this area and it went very smoothly.
