Please accept this letter of opposition to LD 1020. This is a bad idea for the town of Gorham and state of Maine in General. Not only does this set precedence for the State of Maine to start land banks for no reason other than not supporting a certain project but also sets back years of work both from the state and municipality it impacts.
