TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT of L.D. 727

An Act to Restore Repeal Certain Immunization Requirements for Schools By Regina Creeley M. Ed. April 7, 2025

Good Morning Senator Rafferty, Representative Murphy and Distinguished Members of the Educational and Cultural Affairs Committee.

My name is Regina Creeley and I am testifying in support of L.D. 727, An Act to Repeal Certain Immunization Requirements for Schools. My residence is in Hudson and I taught Special Education in Old Town for thirty years. In 2014, I was voted Special Education Professional of the year (by the Maine Administrators of Services for Children with Disabilities (MADSEC)).

No medical procedure is without risk. Like all medical procedures, vaccines have risks. This committee should not be voting to require parents to give their small preschool children vaccines that have risks associated with them. Every vaccine insert contains a huge amount of serious side effects associated with that vaccine.

Many of the listed side effects are associated with life long disability. The disability rate among Maine children is increasing every year. Who on this committee can read those vaccine inserts and feel confident in voting to require a small 24 month old daycare toddler to get a medical procedure with all those listed side effects?

I have read the book VAX-UNVAX, LET THE SCIENCE SPEAK which contains over 100 peer reviewed studies that shows unvaccinated people are healthier than vaccinated people. I have read seven other books on the history of vaccines and the many ingredients in vaccines and the profit motive in vaccines. The books are chock full of information that I didn't know beforehand. Now in 2025, children before the age of 18 get 72 doses of vaccines if they follow the CDC guidelines. The books I have read state that there have been NO randomized controlled studies with inert placebos conducted to prove that the CDC vaccine schedule is safe.

One thing I do know is that the rate of childhood illness and disability is going up and up. The CDC does not have an explanation. If this trend continues, we will not have a viable society. No society can function with disability rates going up each year.
